

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No.18 OF 2006.

REGULATIONS

MADE by the Minister under Section 10 (38) of the Public Health Act 1968 (15 of 1968).

(Gazetted 22nd June, 2006.)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the –

Short title.

PUBLIC HEALTH (EMBALMERS AND FUNERAL DIRECTORS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006.

2. In these Regulations the Public Health (Embalmers and Funeral Directors) Regulations 1987 is referred to as “the Principal Regulations”.

Interpretation.

3. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical order the following definitions -

Amendment of regulation
2 of the Principal
Regulations.

“ “Member State” has the same meaning assigned to it in the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas establishing the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), including the CARICOM Single Market and Economy signed at Nassau, The Bahamas, on 5th July 2001;

“national” means a person who –

- (a) is a citizen of a Member State; or
- (b) has a connection with a Member State of a kind which entitles that person to be regarded as belonging to or,

if it be so expressed, as being a native or resident of such Member State for the purposes of the laws thereof relating to immigration;”.

Amendment of regulation
4 of the Principal
Regulations.

4. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after subregulation (1) the following new subregulation -

“(1A) Subregulation (1) (b) shall not apply to a national of a Member State.”.

Amendment of regulation
5 of the Principal
Regulations.

5. Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulation is amended by inserting after subregulation (2) the following new subregulation-

“(2A) Subregulation (2) (b) shall not apply to a national of a Member State.

Commencement.

6. This Regulation shall come into force on the 7th day of June, 2006.
